Overview:

To the delight of tourists, the county of Rhondda Cynon Taf is reverting to its pre-industrial beauty following the demise of the mining industry in the area, making the diverse and often spectacular built and natural environments one of its greatest assets.

In addition to this tourist appeal, the county's towns are all in close proximity to the capital city of Cardiff, with good road and rail links and relatively affordable housing making the area highly desirable for newly weds and families with young and teenage children. Protecting public safety and deterring crime are key priorities for the council, which selected CDS to design and install a public access space CCTV system because the company was able to demonstrate vast experience of similar projects.

Project description:

CDS designed and installed a large-scale state-of-the-art CCTV security system comprising 120 cameras and utilising fibre optic cabling, secure wireless technology and digital recording, all linked to one control room in a central location.

The system covered the towns of Pontypridd, Treorchy, Tonypany, Clydach Vale, Talbot Green, Pontyclun, Mountain Ash, Abercynon, Aberdare and Porth. CDS consulted closely with the council to ensure the scheme was well suited to each of the towns.

Thanks to CDS' independent status, it was able to review products from the whole market and provide the council with entirely unbiased advice about what would be the best equipment to deliver the required level of performance.
